Families bringing up children with disabilities, brain injury or life-threatening conditions have such diverse and poorly understood problems that they deserve special attention. For many parents, looking after a disabled child with a complex or rare health condition is a life-long responsibility. Their child may not grow up and leave home as other children do, and their requirement for complex care and support does not reduce over time as they grow older. In fact for many it increases as they become bigger, heavier, stronger or more challenging, and parents and carers themselves become less physically able to manage. This is where we help. Our services help families to cope and children to lead more independent lives.

Frontline services

We offer every child with a disability, neurological or life limiting condition access to a high-quality, family-centred care and support centre, with services provided in a 12 acre rural setting in Lancashire.

What we offer

We are responsive to and respectful of the diverse needs of children, their families and carers.

Our philosophy is built around 'children first', that is through a needs-led, problem-solving approach. Rather than relying on diagnostic labels, we want to enable families to pursue ordinary lives and see their children achieve their full potential.

Our services have been developed in response to the needs of parents and children. We work closely with welfare teams and external agencies so that we can maximise the impact of our support services.

We provide the following:

- The Legacy Nursery
- Baby room
- Parent and child classes
- Rehabilitation via trans-disciplinary team
- Holiday clubs
- Weekend activities
- Rainbow House Nursery
- Extensive outdoor activities
- Sensory room and gardens

The Legacy Rainbow House is open 50 weeks per year, Monday to Saturday. The services are built around the holistic philosophy and practice known as Conductive Education.
